



2020 Annual Scientific Competition in Structural Chemistry



Organized by the Struchkov Prize Association

What: An international scientific competition established in memory of the prominent Russian crystallographer professor Yuri T. Struchkov (1926-1995). Top laureates will receive certificates and monetary prizes that total \$5,000.

When: The application deadline is September 15, 2020.

Why: The Struchkov Prize is an important early career recognition that boosts the winner's acknowledgment and respect within the crystallographic community.

Who: All young (under 36 years of age) scientists working in the field of structural chemistry are eligible to apply.

How: The applicants should submit their cover letter, list of publications and a short summary of the applicant's work in English or Russian.

Winner selection: The prizes are awarded by an eight-member jury of distinguished crystallographers working in different countries.

History: Since its inception in 1997, the Association has held 22 annual competitions, awarded 27 top and 50 secondary prizes. The Struchkov Prize is funded by former colleagues and students of Prof. Struchkov, researchers who used to know him personally or were closely familiar and appreciative of his scientific achievements as well as his contributions to organization and development of chemical crystallography in Russia. We are especially happy to see among the supporters recent laureates. Currently, the Struchkov Prize Association, a non-profit organization registered in the US, is also supported by corporate sponsors. Over time, the annual prize fund of Struchkov Prize increased substantially, from \$500 in 1997 to more than \$5,000 in 2018; 100% of all donations collected during any current year are distributed among the winners of Struchkov competition by the end of the same year.
